Floor Plans



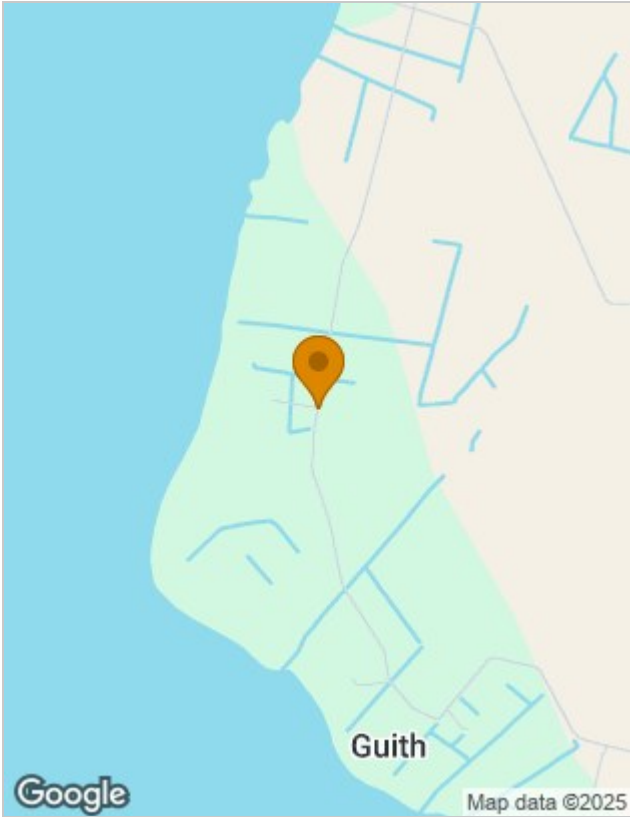
