See Orkney Islands Council planning reference 24/067/PP. Mary Arnold-Forster Architects (MAFA) is a Highland architecture studio working across rural locations throughout Scotland and the UK. It was formed by Mary in 2016 to create quiet, humane, restrained and beautifully crafted places and spaces based on a rigorous study of site, context, landscape and brief to try to create a backdrop for people's work, their art and lives.

The building warrant application has been submitted for this property and is awaiting approval, reference 25/008. A building start date has been agreed with a local contractor for January 2026. Full cost plans for this project are available on request.

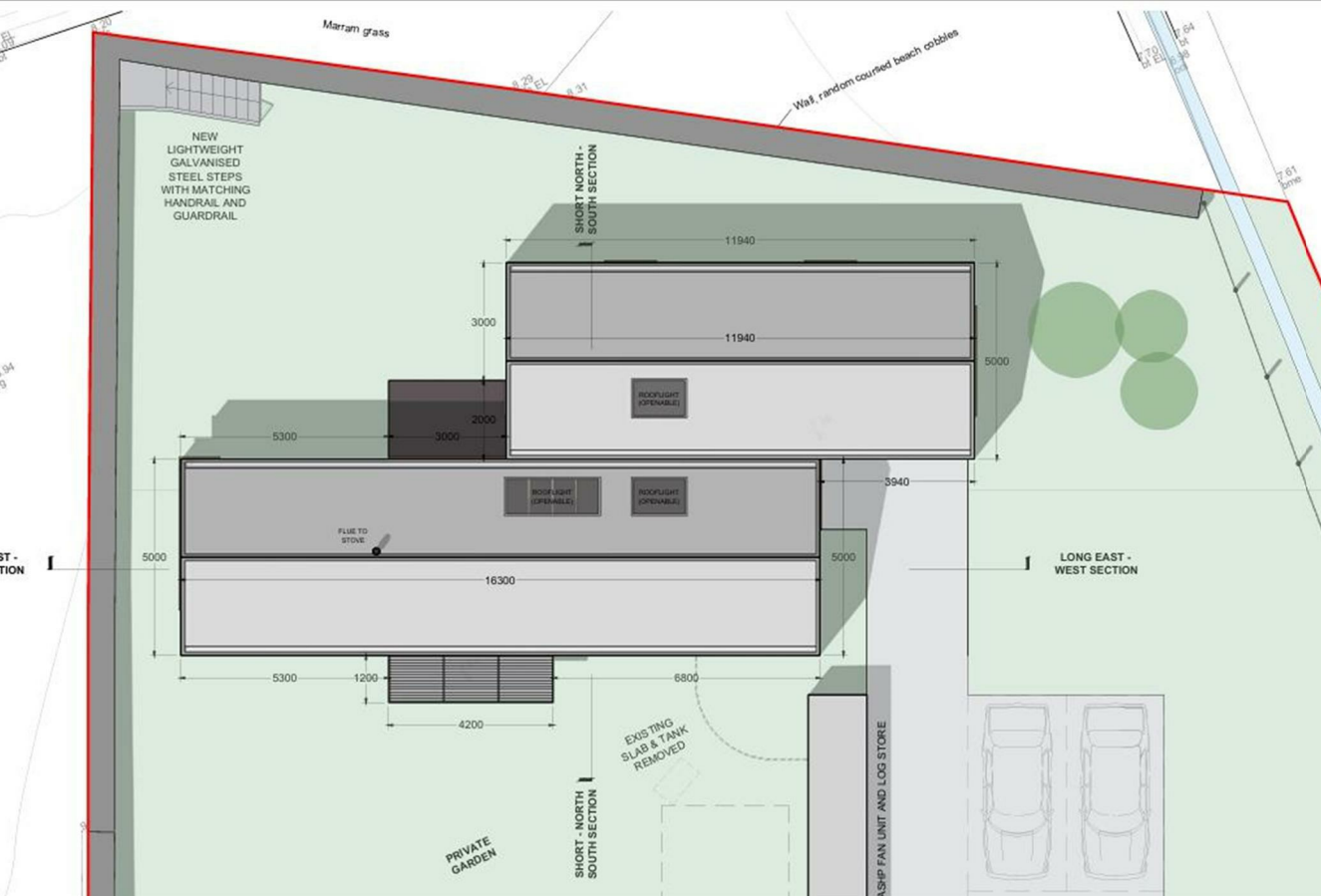

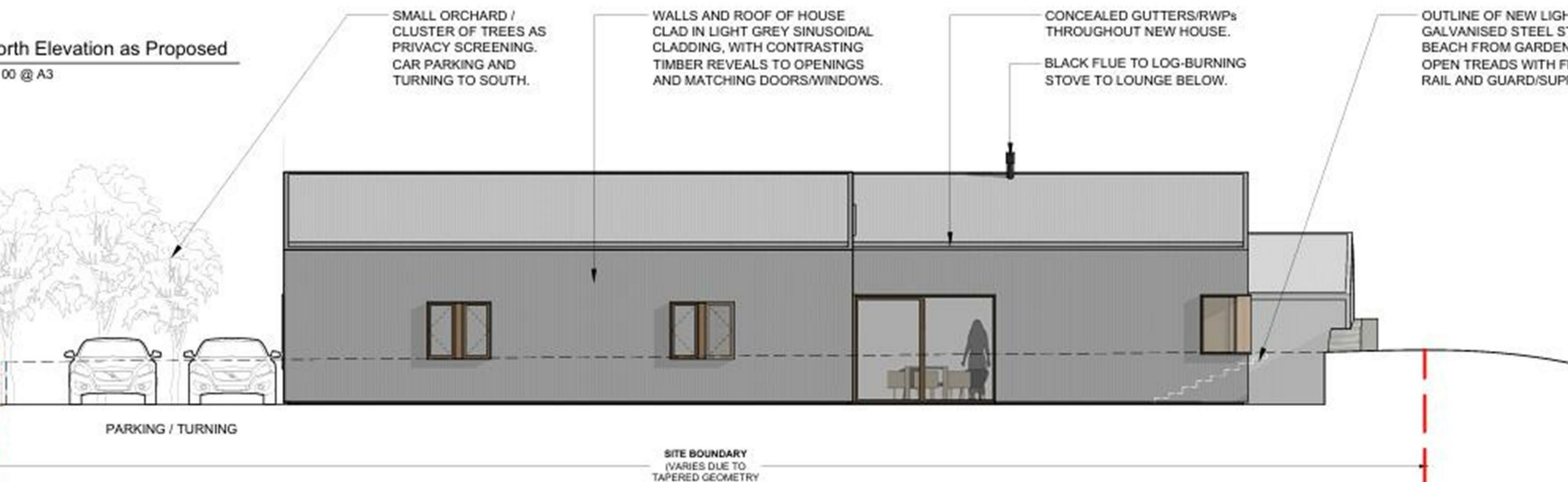

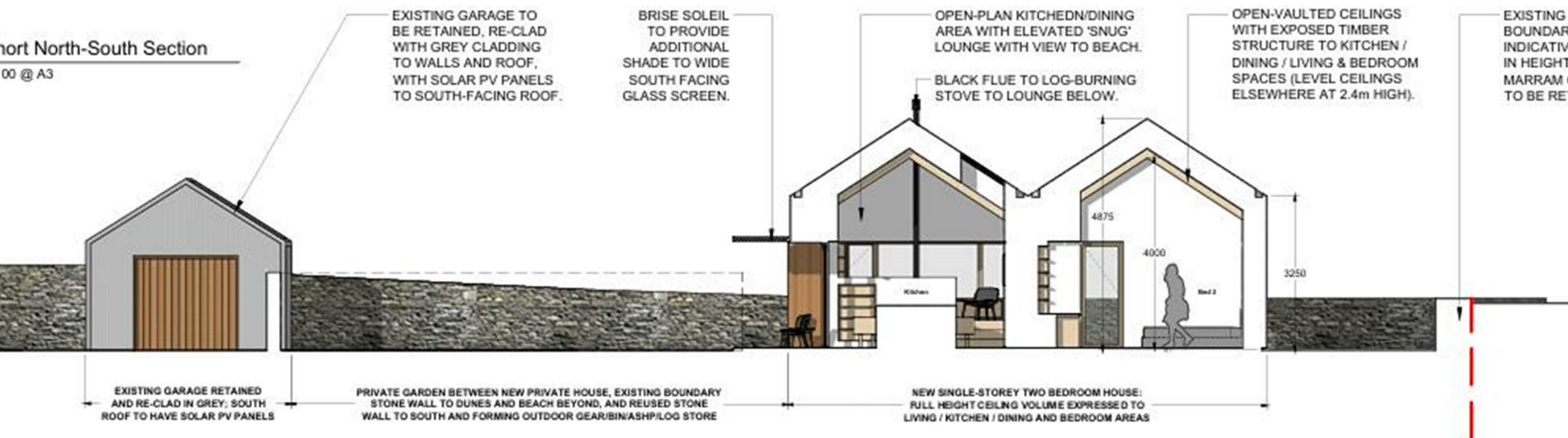
North Elevation as Proposed

Short North-South Section

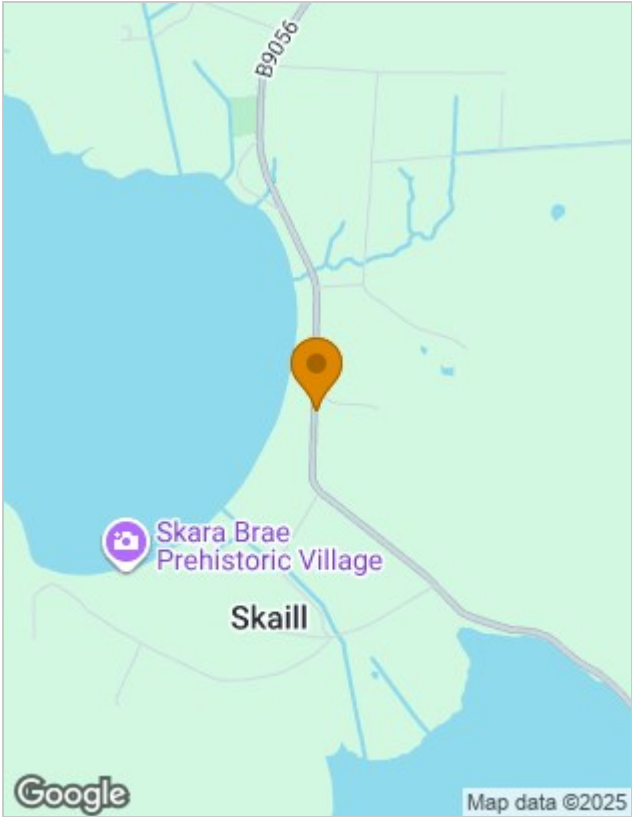
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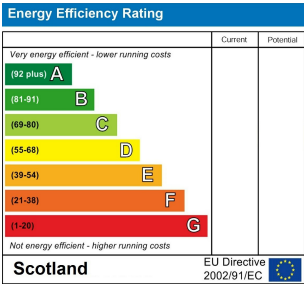
Floor Plans
